For the OCHA this means we are no longer responsible for any maintenance costs of the Clubhouse and for future refurbishment. This will be the responsibility of the General Community and Joaquin. In future the OCHA will only receive funding from third party sponsorship. Andrew Millard's article in this newsletter gives you more insight and detail about the purchase.

The other major event was the completion of the first 2 stages of the refurbishment. The disruption is nearly over with only the activity room floor and work to the Toldos to come.

## **Special Events**

Alongside the regular 'gatherings' the Owners Clubhouse hosts different events for all to enjoy. These are advertised well in advance on the Owners Club Website and Clubhouse Association Members are emailed directly with all the details. The events are varied: Parties, Workshops, Charity Events, DayBreaks and special sponsored events.



The Owners' Clubhouse ("OCH") had its origins as the "Linen House" and served as Inmogolf SL's laundry facility until 1996. Subsequently, **Betty Avery, the General Community** President at the time, reached an agreement with Inmogolf to rent the property and transform it into a clubhouse for the exclusive use of the owners.

Unfortunately, more recently, the relationship with Inmogolf deteriorated and in 2021 the General Community ("GC") was served notice to vacate the building due to an alleged breach of the lease.

Little did I realise, when I put my name forward to be President of the GC that Inmogolf would lodge legal proceedings against the GC on the very day I was elected! Further, the option the GC had within the lease to purchase was legally unenforceable. There was a very real and imminent risk that we would lose the cherished venue forever. And to top it off, Inmogolf were in debt to the GC by circa €200,000 for non-payment of Community Fees.

Something had to be done. So, it is with immense pride and joy that I, on your behalf, reached agreement with Inmogolf to resolve matters by purchasing the OCH on behalf of, and for the benefit of, all owners. It was no easy feat and required both careful negotiation and some clever legal navigation by our Administrator, Ángel Morenilla. The deal also required the authorisation of community Presidents and Elected Representatives.

Without prejudice to the General Community's court case against Inmogolf, meetings were held to agree a fair purchase price, agree payment by Inmogolf of the outstanding Community Fees and for both parties to drop our respective court cases against each other. Most would say this was a pragmatic, business-like stance to take. I hope you agree.

How did we do it? Firstly, to enable the purchase of the property, a limited company OCH LMC S.L. was set-up, 100% owned by the GC. The Administrator is MSB,





operating under the direction of the General Community President and Vice-Presidents via a set of preagreed procedures and protocols. A new Rental Contract, effective 30 September 2023 was signed with Divalcar S.L. to continue to provide the food & beverage service. Agreement has also been reached between OCH LMC S.L. and the Los Molinos Community for the continued leasing of their land and the car park associated with the Clubhouse.

I have asked Vice-President Malcolm Elam to be the GC point of contact ensuring that everything runs smoothly including building maintenance, repairs, enhancements, etc. The Owners´ Clubhouse Association, run by a small committee of dedicated volunteers, continues and remains the driving force behind all social events as well as the clubs, fitness/ health groups and various societies that meet at and use the premises.


#### I feel all of this is extremely positive. It:

- provides a long-term, secure venue for all owners
- enables us to make improvements to the building knowing we are investing back in ourselves as opposed to a third party
- cleared-up two potentially damaging court cases
- ensured the GC received the substantial sum of Community Fees money we were owed
- continues to provides a community hub where likeminded owners and their guests can meet not just now but for many years to come

From now on, the OCH is selffunding. The rent received will go towards maintenance and repairs. In addition and as suitable, any excess can be used towards repaying the initial capital outlay.


This year we have seen a real range of ages, from octogenarians to our youngest participant who was 8!
